FEI Foods Limited Environmental & Sustainability Policy Statement

At FEI Foods Limited, we are committed to operating as a responsible and sustainable food manufacturing business. We recognise the importance of environmental stewardship and carbon impact and the role we play in shaping a sustainable future. We shall operate in a way whereby sustainability is embedded in our values, guiding our decisions and actions to minimise our environmental impact as a whole and contribute positively to the community. We are passionate about this agenda in reducing our environmental effect through sustainable practices and making consistent gains to enhancing our environmental performance.

- **Leadership and Accountability:** We have established clear responsibilities for environmental aspects at all levels within the business, and individuals are accountable for fulfilling their roles, providing adequate resources to enable the effective implementation and operation of this policy.
- **Legal Compliance:** Ensure full compliance with all relevant environmental & sustainability laws, regulations, and standards. We will actively monitor changes in legislation and strive to exceed legal requirements.
- **Risk Assessment and Management:** We will identify, assess, our environmental risks associated with our activities. Control measures will be implemented to minimise or eliminate our environmental impact.

We will also make investments in energy-saving devices, explore options for renewable energy sources, and routinely calculating our carbon impact. - **Waste Reduction and Recycling:** Clear plans to actively pursue waste reduction initiatives throughout our supply chain. This includes minimising packaging waste, promoting the use of recyclable and compostable materials, and implementing effective waste management practices. Our goal is to move towards a circular economy where waste is minimised, and resources are recycled.
