



FEI Foods Ltd – Gender Pay Gap Report 2023

In line with current legislation, FEI Foods Ltd will be publishing a Gender Pay Gap report on an annual basis.

The report for the snapshot dated 5th April 2023 can be found below:

- The Mean Gender Pay Gap for FEI Foods Ltd is 17.0%
- The Median Gender Pay Gap for FEI Foods Ltd is 3.3%
- The Mean Gender Bonus Gap for FEI Foods Ltd is 81.4%
- The Median Gender Bonus Gap for FEI Foods Ltd is 4.8%
- The proportion of male employees at FEI Foods Ltd receiving a bonus is 13.6% and the proportion of female employees receiving a bonus is 23.7%
- Pay Quartiles by gender:

Band	Male	Female	Description
A	67%	33%	Includes all employees whose standard hourly rate places them at or below the lower quartile.
B	72%	28%	Includes all employees whose standard hourly rate places them above the lower quartile but at or below the median.
C	67%	33%	Includes all employees whose standard hourly rate places them above the median but at or below the upper quartile.
D	84%	16%	Includes all employees whose standard hourly rate places them above the upper quartile.

The figures indicated above have been calculated using the methodologies used in the Equality Act 2010 (Gender Pay Gap Information) Regulations 2017. Several hourly paid employees had unpaid absences during the relevant pay period which impacted their respective status as a “full pay relevant employee”.

As per the Equality Act 2010, employees of all genders must receive equal pay for the same (or largely similar) work. FEI Foods Ltd is strongly committed to the principle of equal opportunities and equal treatment for all employees, regardless of sex, race, religion or belief, age, marriage or civil partnership, pregnancy / maternity / paternity, sexual orientation, gender reassignment or disability. The business has a specific ‘Diversity, Equality and Inclusion Policy’, which is adhered to when determining job roles and pay grades in the interest of ensuring a fair structure.



We are pleased to observe that the Mean & Median Gender Pay Gap has improved since 2022. It is our conclusion that this improvement is a result of our ongoing commitment to appointing and promoting women into senior positions. Furthermore, reviewing the wider workforce population, we are satisfied that there is absolute parity for like roles regardless of Gender.

86 members of staff received a bonus during the relevant period. We have observed that the Mean & Median Bonus Gender Pay Gap has improved since last year, which we feel is further evidence of our commitment to appointing and promoting women into senior positions, where bonuses are more likely to be applicable. The proportion of males to females receiving a bonus payment are 13.6% male, 23.7% female.

FEI Foods Ltd remains to be committed to ensuring that the Gender Pay Gap is minimised as far as possible. To achieve this, FEI Foods Ltd will continue to undertake the following initiatives:

- Annual scrutiny of its Gender Pay Gap data
- Monitoring the proportions of male and female candidates applying for jobs and being recruited, while also monitoring proportions of male and female candidates leaving the business and their reason for leaving.
- Continued Support to employees before, during and after any maternity or parental leave taken.
- Monitoring, updating and ensuring adherence to our 'Diversity, Equality and Inclusion Policy'
